BIOGRAPHY

KATHARINE PETKOVSKI (b. 1997) is a Toronto-based Canadian composer and pianist known for her emotive, minimalist music and cross-disciplinary approach. Featured on CBC's "30 hot Canadian classical musicians under 30" list, her work has been performed by ensembles like *musica intima*, Amadeus Choir, the National Youth Choir of Canada, and the Odin Quartet. She has participated in the Scarborough Philharmonic Orchestra's New Generation Composition Program, *novum musica*, and the Amadeus Choral Creation Lab.

In 2024, Katharine received the Diane Loomer Award for her choral piece "When Music Sounds," leading to her first publishing deal with Cypress Choral Music. She also won the NDSU Edwin Fissinger Choral Composition Prize (2023) and the Bedford Trio Composition Competition (2021). In film, her scores have been showcased at festivals like VIFF and TIFF Next Wave. Katharine holds both a BMus and MMus in Composition from the University of Toronto and is an active member of the Screen Composer's Guild of Canada, the Alliance for Women Film Composers, and the Canadian League of Composers.
